Approval of Support Medina and Loretto to Request State Funding for Railroad Crossing Improvements

Discussion:

The Cities of Loretto and Medina are seeking funding through the 2016 Bonding Bill to improve four railroad crossings. The improvements would bring the railroad crossings up to a standard which would allow them to qualify for federal quiet zone status. One of the crossings, Town Line Road, is split between Medina and Independence. Loretto and Medina have asked that the City of Independence City Council support their request for funding. The cities are seeking 100% funding which amounts to \$300,000 per intersection for the improvements.

Requested Action:

The Council is asked to consider **RESOLUTION 16-0126-03**, a resolution supporting the cities of Medina and Loretto in seeking funding through the 2016 Bonding Bill.
